

## DECD Strategic Plan

Our priority is to maximize each and every child's learning, to help them become the most successful learners they can be, developing confident individuals. Educators use the National Early Years Learning Framework to provide the goals to plan for and support your child's learning and development towards positive outcomes.

### Assessment and Reporting

Preschool teachers keep records of children's progress and are able to give you feedback about your child's learning – please let the teachers know if you have any questions or would like to know how your child is progressing. At the beginning of your child's second term with us you will be invited to contribute to their individual learning plan.

As your child moves on to school the teacher will complete a statement of learning which you will receive. With your permission, this will also be sent to your child's school.

At this time you will also receive your child's portfolio of work which shows how your child has progressed during their time at the centre.

## How to enrol.

Please complete an intention to enrol form as soon as possible after your child turns 2. Please note -we give priority of access to families in our local area as described in the site priority of access policy. ## Magill Kindergarten

All South Australian children are entitled to preschool education in the year before they start school, provided they have turned 4 prior to 1st May.

Children are entitled to attend up to 15 hours of preschool a week, with a qualified Early Childhood Teacher.

Aboriginal children and those under the guardianship of the Minister may begin at age 3. Proof of age is required.



All eligible families and children enrolled in the preschool program will have access to all government funded DECD support services. Please speak to the preschool staff if you have any concerns about your child's development.

At Magill Kindergarten we have a group size of approximately 30 children, which gives each child plenty of individual attention and opportunities to build friendships with other children.

We have a purpose built kindergarten, which is light and airy indoors. It is situated next to an oval which we use for practising ball skills.

Our outdoor learning area is shady and inviting. The children assist with planting and caring for vegetables as part of the curriculum. At the back of our kindergarten we have a nature play garden (under development) and turtle pond. Occasionally we are visited by koalas!



We have regular visits to Magill Primary School.

Literacy is a key focus area of our curriculum, and we are implementing a number of programs to ensure that our children have every opportunity to maximize their skills in this area.

STEM (Science technology, Engineering and Mathematics) is a curriculum area we are developing.

**Monday, Tuesday 8.15 until 3.45**

**Thursday Friday 8.15 until 3.45**

**Fees are currently \$120 for the term plus a \$10 fundraising levy.**

**Children bring their lunch to kindergarten, this is stored in the fridge. They also need a snack which complies with our healthy food policy.**

**Prior to entry we offer transition visits for children. The timing of these visits varies according to our full time enrolments.**
